HGAC's GAR Hall, 53 E. Middle St.

We will gather in HGAC's headquarters, GAR Hall, in the heart of historic Gettysburg (53 East Middle Street). From Lincoln Square via Route 30, go south on Baltimore Street (Business Route 15 South) one block to Middle Street. Turn left (East) onto East Middle Street. The GAR Hall is in the middle of the first block on the right. A monument and two cannons are in front. Municipal parking lots with meters are on both sides of Middle Street before reaching the Hall. On-street parking at meters is also available along the north side of East Middle Street. There are no meter charges on Sundays in Gettysburg.
