This two-day event is scheduled for June 17th and 18th, beginning with a special evening touring an historic barn owned by HBFF of PA director Eugene Wingert. Friday's events begin at 4 p.m. at the Wingert barn located at 722 Loudon Road, Saint Thomas, PA 17252. The annual banquet will begin at 6 p.m. at St. Thomas Fire Company, located on Route 30 at 34 School House Road, St. Thomas. A buffet dinner will be served by Sunnyway Diner & Deli Shop of Greencastle, with roast beef, stuffed chicken breast, baked lasagna, tossed salad, mashed potatoes, succotash, baked beans, an assortment of baked pies and drinks. Barn documenter Phil Schaff of Chambersburg and HBFF of PA director Dianna Heim will be presenting an informative program entitled: "Cumberland Valley Barns: Past and Present—Brick End Barns of Franklin County" following a brief business meeting of the HBFF of PA.

Saturday will be devoted to touring eight historic barns in Franklin County. A boxed lunch and tour at the Conococheague Institute, Mercersburg, will divide the day of historic barns.
